

Table Runner & Napkins

Finished size Table Runner: (45 x 100 cm), Napkins (30 x 30 cm).



Sewing Supplies

- · Husqvarna Viking Designer I
- · In aqua green linen 20 3/8" x 41 3/4" (52 x 106 cm) for Table Runner and for each Napkins 14 1/4" x 14 1/4" (36 x 36 cm)
- · Sulky 40 wt. Embroidery thread
- · Sewing thread
- · Husqvarna Viking Tear Away™ stabilizer
- · Embroidery disk 45, Fantasy Flowers by Margit Grimm

Optional presser feet

· Candlewicking Foot (412 51 08-45) (see Accessory User's Guide for instruction how to use the foot)

CUT

Cut the pieces for the table runner and the place mat according to above measurements.

EMBROIDER


Table runner: Select design 8. Mark out the centre point of the embroidery 4" (10 cm) from the long side and 6" (15 cm) from the short side. Hoop the fabric in the midsize hoop with tear away stabilizer underneath the fabric. Embroider the design in matching colour shades to the fabric. (We have used aqua green and white embroidery thread on aqua green linen). Place Mat: Mark out the centre point of the embroidery 4" (10 cm) from the sides. Embroider only the part of the design that is in position 2.


SEW

Turn under the edges 1/4" (6 mm) and press. Fold and press a 1" (2.5 cm) hem on all sides. Press lightly and unfold again.

Thread your sewing machine with sewing thread. Snap on presser foot A and select Seam on your Sewing Advisor. Sew a mitred corner by folding the edges to the right side. Pin and mark a 45 degree angle. Illustration A.

Sew the corner diagonally on the marked line with straight stitch, length 2.5. Illustration B.





Repeat for all four corners. Trim excess fabric, turn right side out and press.

Rethread with white embroidery thread. Snap on the Candlewicking Foot. (See Accessory User's Guide for instruction how to use the foot.) Sew candlewicking 3/4" (2 cm) from the edge all around the table runner and place mats. Illustration C.


